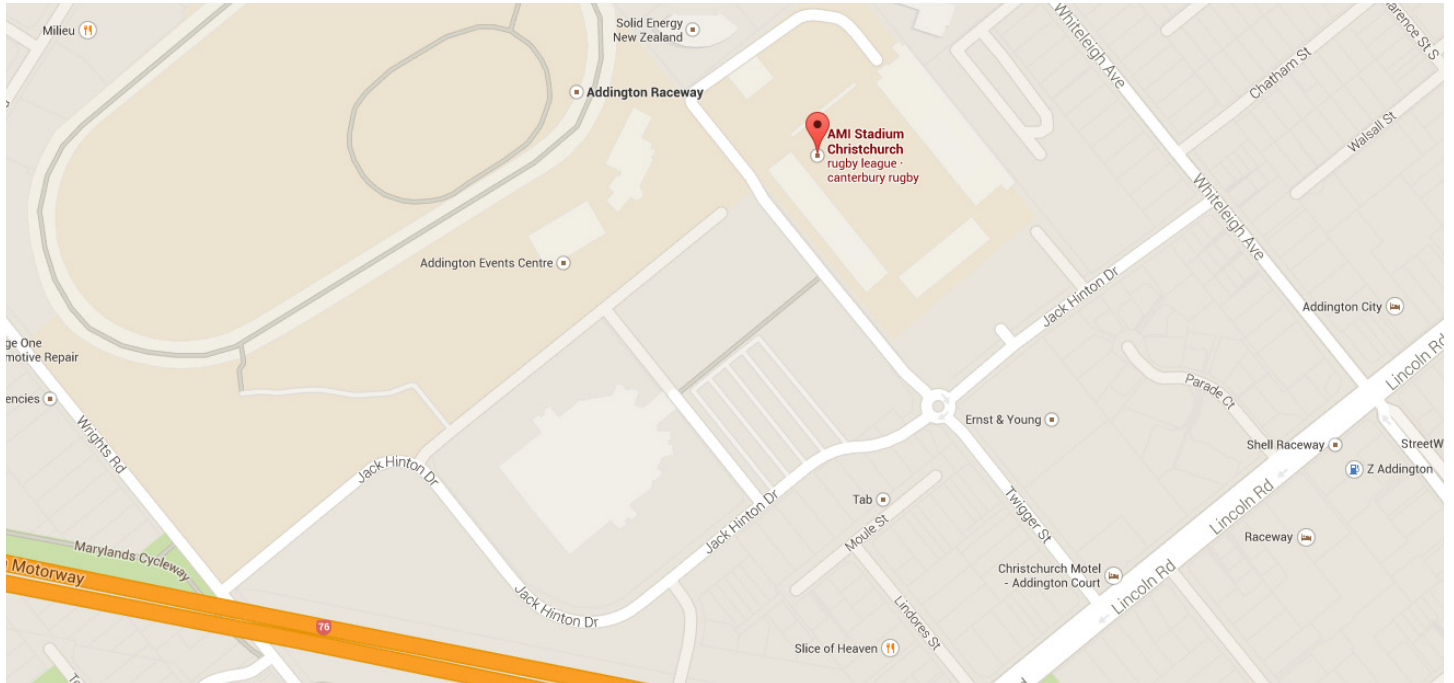


Getting to and around AMI Stadium

Always allow more time than you expect to get to and from the venue and aim to arrive at least 45 minutes before the start of the rugby or event. Traffic congestion can be heavy for the majority of events particularly if there are other events taking place in the precinct or during peak commuter travel times.

Jack Hinton Drive between Whiteleigh Ave and Twigger St is closed on large event days. Off-street parking is also often restricted.

To check to see if there is a Traffic Management Plan in place for an event, visit www.transportforchristchurch.govt.nz.



Parking is very limited in and around the stadium on event days, particularly when events are on at the Arena or Raceway. Please ensure you check the event listing on www.vbase.co.nz for event specific and up to date car parking information.

Disability parking is available onsite via the Wrights Road entry. Vehicles must have a valid and appropriate Mobility Pass visible.



Metro Bus Stops are located nearby on Lincoln Road and Whiteleigh Ave. Visit www.metroinfo.org.nz for more information and timetables.



If you require a taxi pick up post event we recommend you book this well in advance as taxis can be in high demand in particular later in the evening.



Pedestrian access is available from all points of entry in to the area. Please stay on footpaths and sides of roads for your safety and that of others.

Bike racks are available for cyclists and are by the entrance gates. Please ensure that you lock your bikes securely to the rack.

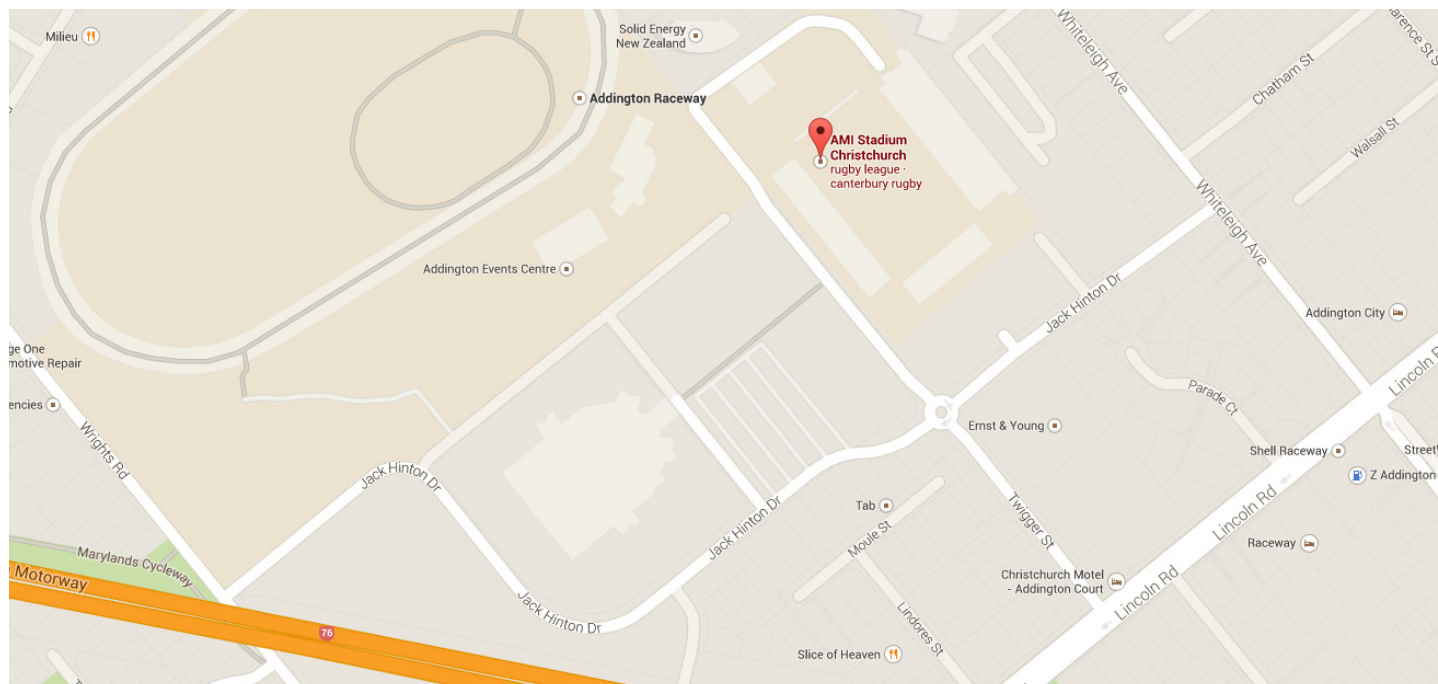
AMI Stadium is smoke free at all times. There are secure outdoor smoking areas located outside Gates A and B. Venue staff will help to direct you to this area.

Wheelchair access and companion seating is available at AMI Stadium for all Crusaders (Investec Super Rugby) and Canterbury (ITM Cup) matches. The wheelchair and companion seating area is located in the lower section of the City Care Stand. The number of seats available is limited so the allocation of seating is limited to one wheelchair and one companion seat per customer.

Baby Change facilities are located in the accessible toilets at each end of the City Care Stand. Strollers or prams are not permitted inside the venue. If you need bottles or baby food heated please see the staff located in the Food and Beverage outlets.



Ticket Direct manage ticket sales for all Rugby events at AMI Stadium. The Ticket Direct Box Office generally opens at 9am on Game Days, but we recommend contacting CRFU on 03 379 8300 to confirm, as this may change depending on the game.

Patrons may bring in the following food and drink items into the public areas of the venue:



- Non alcoholic drinks in sealed plastic bottles under 1 litre in size
- Non commercial food for personal consumption such as sandwiches, fruit, biscuits and cakes, provided it is not in commercial packaging or wrappers

Conditions of Entry



AMI STADIUM IS SMOKEFREE AT ALL TIMES

DRESS CODE

All persons entering the Stadium must be appropriately dressed.

The right of admittance is reserved to Stadium staff and decision will be final. In particular no person will be permitted entry to the Stadium with:

- bare feet
- clothing containing offensive messages (or gang patches)
- inappropriate costume
- high vis reflective clothing

BEHAVIOUR

Patrons may be refused entry to or asked to leave the Stadium if they:

- are not in possession of a valid ticket or pass
- are the subject of a current trespass order
- attempt to bring in, or are found with, prohibited items (Full list of items below)
- appear intoxicated or under the influence of drugs, or otherwise behave in a disorderly or offensive manner
- fail to comply with security or gate staff requests, including submission to a search
- are carrying out unauthorised activities within the Stadium

PERMITTED ITEMS

Unopened clear plastic non-alcoholic drink bottle under 1 litre

Homemade food items for personal consumption eg. sandwich

Personal umbrella not exceeding 1m - please note no umbrellas within seating bowls

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Alcohol or Illegal Substances

Cans / Glass

Chilly Bins

Unsealed Bottles or Containers of any size

Drink Bottles and Containers 1 litre and over

Flasks / Thermos

Commercial Food eg. Fish and Chips

Animals (except guide dogs)

Chairs/Stools/Furniture

Flags with handles exceeding 1.0m

Offensive Signs or Banners

Whistles / Musical Instruments / Air Horns / Vuvuzelas

Flares / Fireworks / Laser Lights

Skateboards / Scooters / Prams / Strollers / Pushchairs

Dangerous Goods / Weapons / Anything that appears to look like a weapon

Gang patches

Recording devices for commercial purposes
