Our Coaching Philosophy

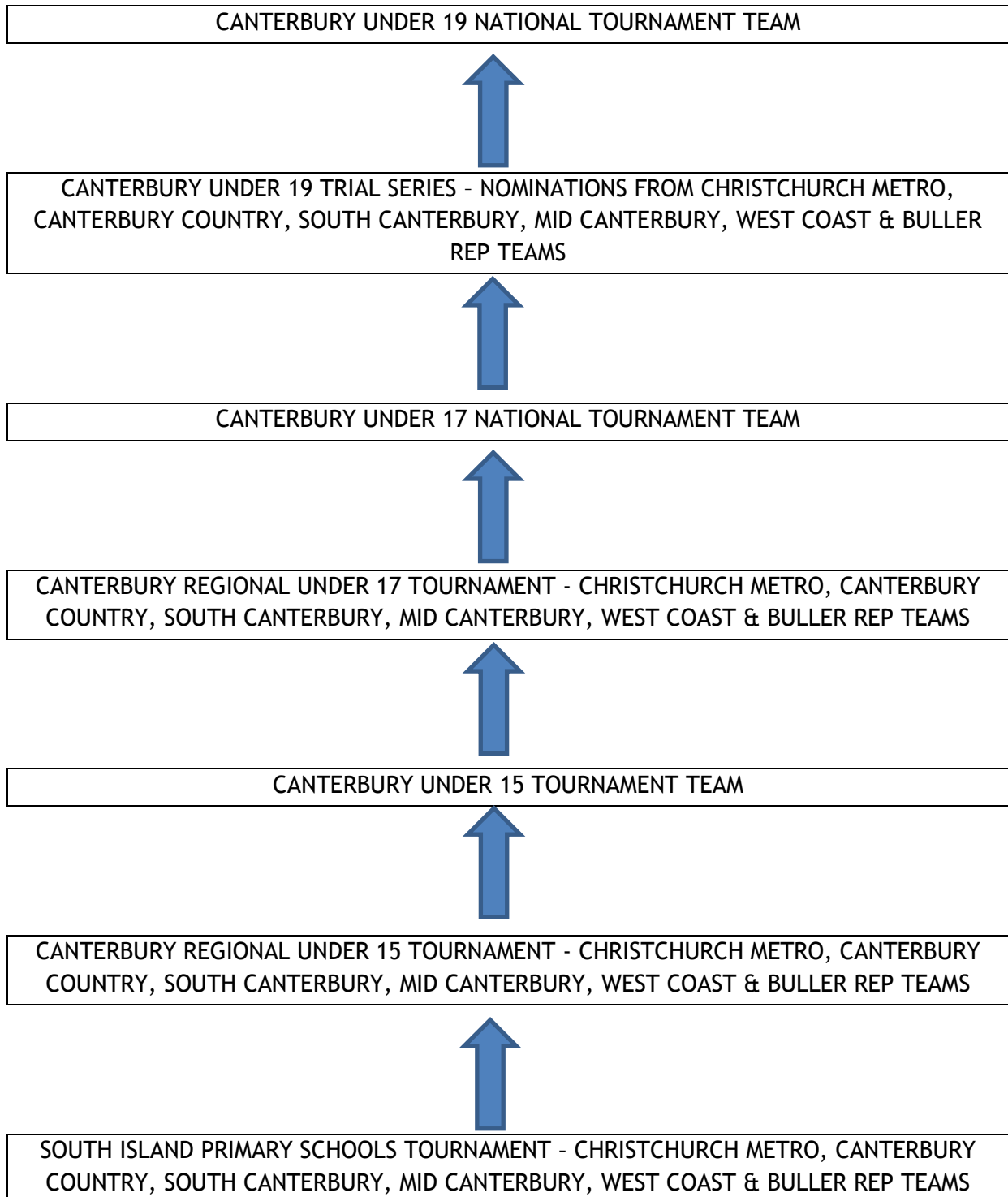
To maximise the development potential of Canterbury cricketers by providing an enjoyable continuous learning environment that produces self-sufficient athletes who work hard, train smart and play fair.

It is important to provide a balance between individual athlete development and team experiences.

The structure and composition of Canterbury under age representative teams will be reviewed on an annual basis. District & sub associations of Canterbury Cricket provide participation and representative team selection opportunities. It is the general philosophy of Canterbury Cricket that focuses on Canterbury representative team selections and experiences should begin at the Under 17 level. Canterbury Cricket individual athlete identification begins at primary school level.



MALE REPRESENTATIVE TEAM SELECTION PATHWAY

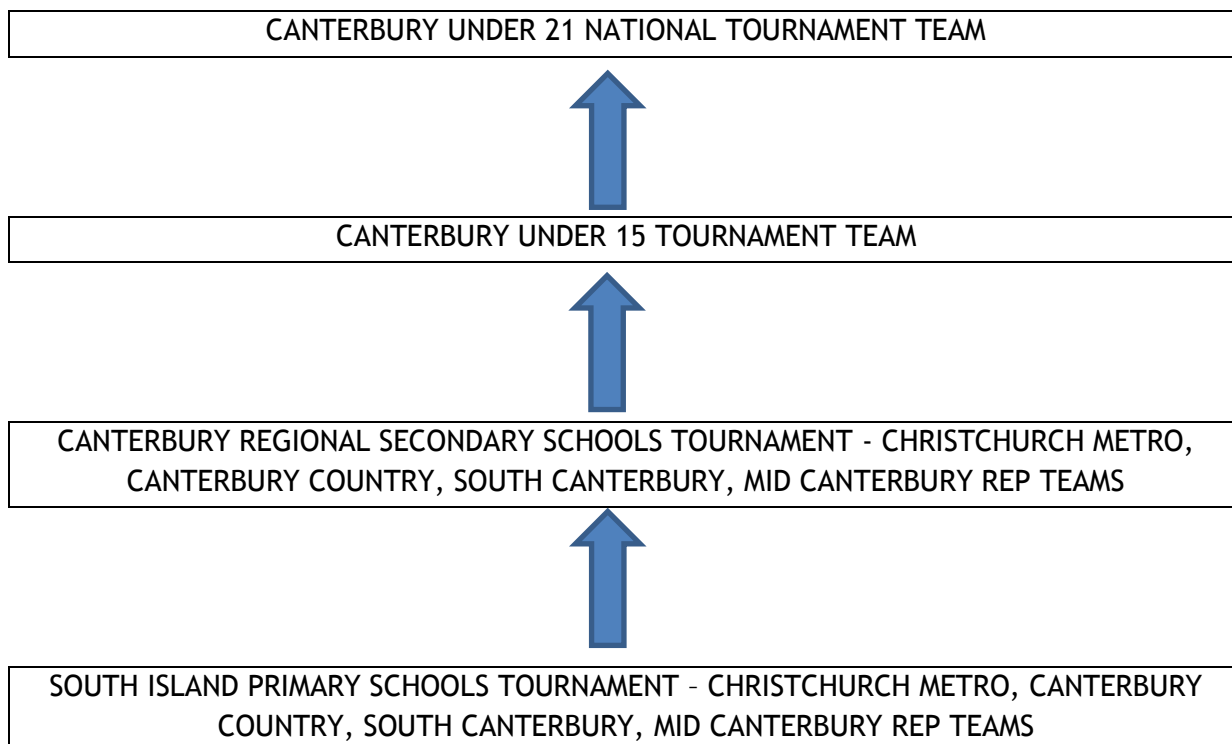

FEMALE REPRESENTATIVE TEAM SELECTION PATHWAY

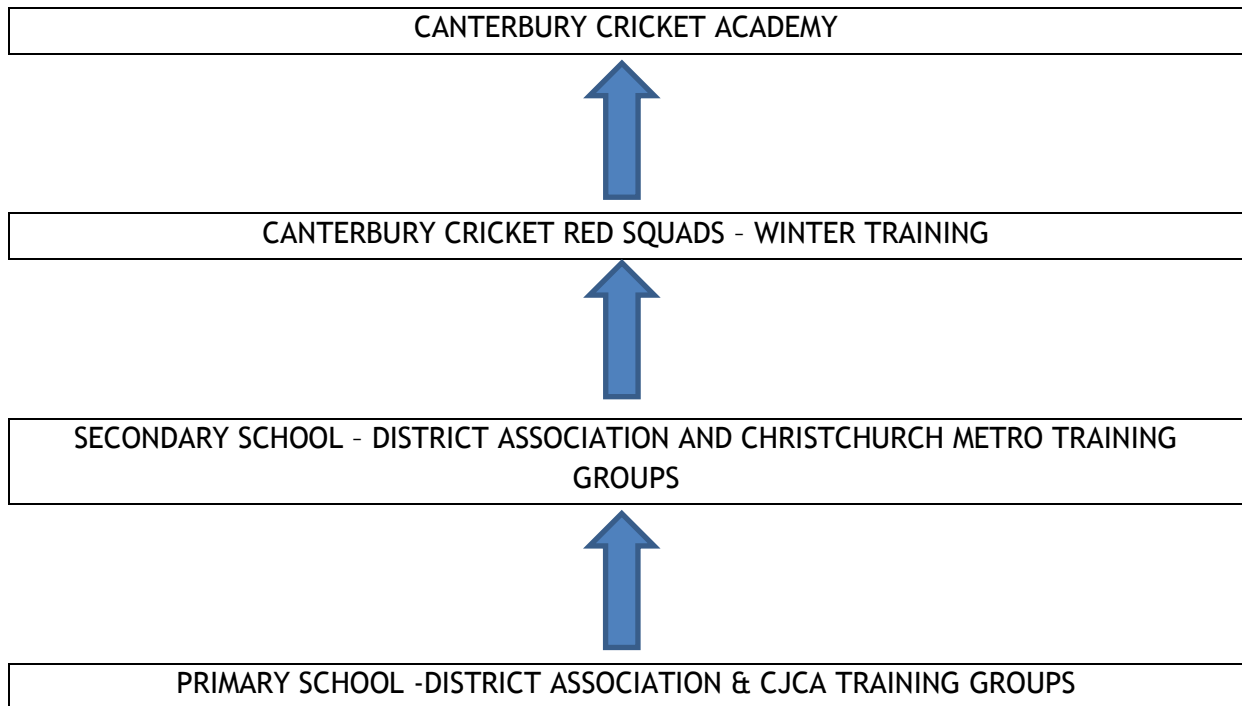

DURHAM PLAYER EXCHANGE

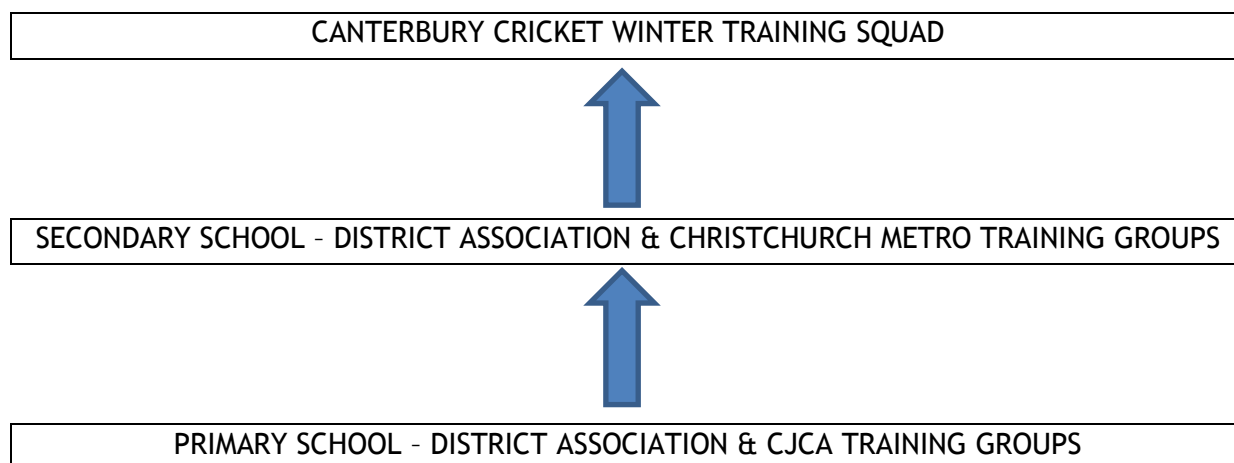
Each season a player is selected by the Canterbury Cricket High Performance team to spend the cricket season at Durham County Cricket Club.

MALE

Under 19 National Tournament team

Selection Panel

- Paul Wiseman (Canterbury Under 19 coach) - convenor
- Andrew Reid (Canterbury Under 17 coach)
- 2 independent selectors

Selection Criteria

The team will be selected following a trials series consisting of the following:

October 12	Trial match
October 19 and 29	Full day training and match simulation days
November 2 and 9	Full day training and match simulation days
December 7 - 9	Trial matches - team named on December 9

Players will be identified to trial for this team through nominations by their respective district or sub association. Players may also be invited by the selectors as a result of having been identified during the course of the season playing for their respective teams and/or involvement in winter training squads at either district/sub association or Canterbury Cricket level. The previous performance history of the player will also be considered.

Itinerary

The team will practice on December 16 & 17 and will play practice matches between January 8 and 10 and compete in the New Zealand Cricket National Tournament at Lincoln between January 13 and January 22.

Cost

Canterbury Cricket subsidises approximately 70% of the total costs. Each player will be required to pay \$626.75. If payment is made prior to the tournament then the fee is \$564.08.

Under 17 National Tournament team

Selection Panel

- Andrew Reid (Canterbury Under 17 coach) - convenor
- Canterbury Cricket staff coach
- 2 independent selectors

Selection Criteria

The team will be selected at the conclusion of the Canterbury Regional Under 17 tournament.

The team will be selected as a result of players having been identified during the course of the season playing for their respective teams and/or involvement in winter training squads at either district/sub association or Canterbury Cricket level, and their performance at the Regional Under 17 tournament or Gillette Cup. The previous performance history of the player will also be considered.

Itinerary

The team will play practice matches on December 20 and 21 and January 7, 8 and 9 and compete in the New Zealand Cricket National Tournament likely to be held in January, 2015.

Cost

Canterbury Cricket subsidises approximately 70% of the total costs. Each player will be required to pay \$494.50. If payment is made prior to the tournament then the fee is \$445.05.

Under 15 tournament team

Selection Panel

- Andrew Reid (Canterbury Cricket Player Development Manager (convenor))
- District association coaches

Selection Criteria

A balanced team will be selected solely based on performances at the Canterbury Regional Under 15 Tournament.

Itinerary

This team will not play any matches.

Cost

There is no cost for players selected in this team.

Female

Under 21 National Tournament team

Selection Panel

- Canterbury Under 21 coach - TBC
- Richard Pithey (Magicians coach)

Selection Criteria

Two teams will be selected to play in a trial match on October 26. These trial teams will be selected as a result of players having been identified during the course of the season playing for their respective teams and/or involvement in winter training squads at either district/sub association or Canterbury Cricket level, and their performance, where applicable, at the Regional Secondary Schools tournament. The previous performance history of the player will also be considered.

The Under 21 team will be selected predominantly as an Under 18 team. We believe this is an age group that requires a focus and as such the Under 21 team will contain at least 9 under 18 players as a selection principle.

Itinerary

The team will play practice matches on November 16 and December 7 and compete in the National Tournament at Lincoln between December 15 and 21.

Cost

Canterbury Cricket subsidises approximately 70% of the total costs. Each player will be required to pay \$391.00. If payment is made prior to the tournament then the fee is \$351.90.

Under 15 tournament team

This team will be selected from the Canterbury Regional Secondary Schools Tournament

Selection Panel

- Canterbury Cricket appointed convenor
- District association coaches

Selection Criteria

Selection will be solely based on performances at the Canterbury Regional Secondary Schools Tournament.

Itinerary

This team will participate in a full-day training session on November 9 and play two matches on November 23 and December 7.

They will also have involvement as part of the Magicians squad at home matches.

Cost

There is no cost for players in this team.

SELECTION CRITERIA

With the exception of tournament teams, when the team will be selected solely on tournament performances, the following criteria will generally be used for selection purposes.

- Tournament performances
- Perceived future potential
- Attitude and commitment
- Fitness
- Availability

TEAM COMPOSITION

When selecting, consideration must be made to the balance of the team in terms of the desired mix of batsmen and bowlers. This may be influenced by, but not limited to, factors such as match formats, playing conditions, surface, tournament duration, and having options to cover for various situations.

CHARACTER

The character of a player including their willingness to work hard, play as a member of a team and show resilience in testing conditions will be a consistent and key consideration in ALL Canterbury under age representative team selections.

ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT & WINNING

Canterbury Under age representative team experiences are focussed on developing the athlete to become the best player he or she can be. This will necessitate the requirement to provide each athlete with different and challenging opportunities within the team environment.

All Canterbury Under age representative teams enter their respective matches and tournaments with the intention and expectation of winning.

However, athlete development is the key priority.
